

Socrative


To use Socrative, teachers need an account to get a room number. Students DO NOT need an account. They simply go to m.socrative.com from any device and enter YOUR room number to begin taking the survey or quiz. The teacher and each student would need a device connected to the internet to distribute and take the quiz.


A. Steps for Teacher Registration and Tutorial:

1. [Click here](#) to sign up for an account.
2. Complete the email and password information to start your registration. You will need to remember these for future access to your account. Students DO NOT need an account.
3. Complete the profile page.

Ready to go! Quick Overview.

Teachers and students can use Socrative on any device with a web browser (tablets, smartphones, laptops, iPod Touches, etc.).

Teachers login at **t.socrative.com** by entering their email and password.

Students login at **m.socrative.com** by entering the "virtual room number" provided by the teacher. Students will then see "Waiting for teacher to start an activity...".

Teachers initiate an activity by selecting it on their main screen (e.g. Multiple Choice, T/F, Quick Quiz).

Students respond on their devices.

Students' results are visible on the Teacher's screen or sent in an email.

B. Import a Quiz:

1. On your home screen, once you are logged in to Socrative, select “Manage Quizzes”.
Remember that teachers go to t.socrative.com to log in with their email and password.
2. Select “Import a Quiz”.
3. Select “Import a Shared Quiz”.
4. Enter the code provided for the shared quiz – Responsible Digital Citizenship Survey

5. You are now able to start the quiz and have students log in to your room to answer the survey.
To start the quiz, select “Start Quiz” and a new window will appear.
Remember that students go to m.socrative.com and enter your “Virtual Room Number”. This can be found at the top of your home page.
6. To start your saved quiz, “Select a saved quiz” and select Responsible Digital Citizenship Survey.
Note that there some advanced options you can select. Be sure to select “Teacher Paced Quiz” so you can decide when to display the next question of the quiz.
